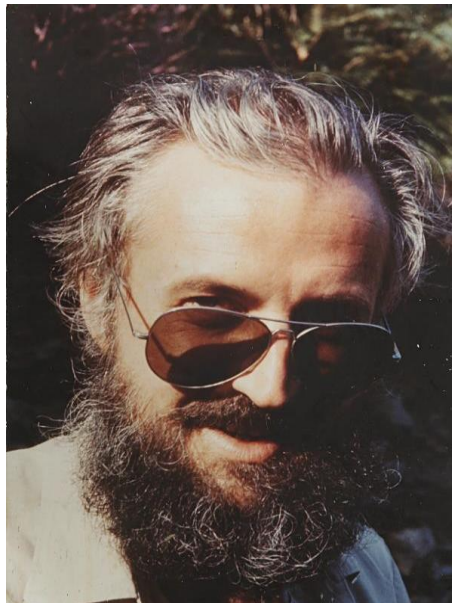

Next page : the day we first visited in 1975, me with the owner at the time, Mr Charrière.



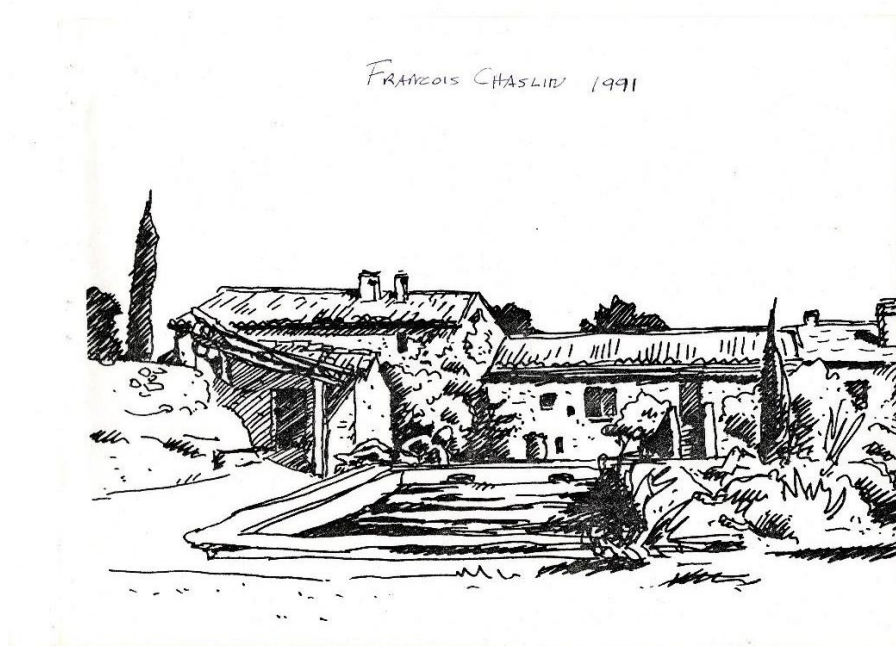
